

## **Information on data protection for the STRABAG Group companies on the processing of your data - Participant information**

### **I. General information**

The controller pursuant to Art. 4 para. 7 GDPR is the respective group company of the STRABAG Group (hereinafter referred to as STRABAG), which is the organiser. The name and contact address of the respective group company responsible can usually be found in the invitation to the event.

### **II. Name and address of the data protection officer**

### **III. Processing of your personal data**

Personal data is any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person.

We process your surname, first name and e-mail address as well as, if applicable, other information that you can find on the form for registering or deregistering for the event, such as mode of arrival, accommodation, with/without accompaniment, children.

This information is necessary for the organisation of the event.

Insofar as further data is processed as part of the organisation of the event or at the event, we will separately comply with the information obligations as part of the design and implementation of the specific data processing operations.

### **IV. Scope and purpose of data processing**

#### **1. Data processing for the execution of orders**

We process your personal data collected through the registration form in order to organise the event you will attend, to confirm your registration or deregistration, to issue your badge and to allow you to change your registration, to reserve transfers or hotel contingents or, if applicable, to make hotel bookings and to issue invoices.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 b) GDPR.

#### **2. Data processing for client loyalty/public relations**

We process your personal data in order to provide you with offers from partners and sponsors for this event, to carry out analyses of this event, to ensure satisfactory networking by including your name and company on the participants list, and for post-event follow-up (e.g., sending a thank-you email).

The legal basis for the data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) GDPR. The legitimate interest results from the purposes of the processing.

### **3. Data processing for the fulfilment of legal obligations**

We are subject - like all companies - to various legal obligations. In these cases, we only process your personal data to the extent necessary for these legal requirements. In the context of events, these legal requirements relate in particular to control and reporting obligations under tax law.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 para 1 sentence 1 c) GDPR in conjunction with the relevant regulations.

### **V. Direct survey / Third party survey**

STRABAG collects and processes personal data that we have received from you when you register or deregister.

### **VI. Recipients of the data**

#### **1. Access authorisation within our company**

Within STRABAG, only those persons have access to the personal data who absolutely require such access for the organisation and follow-up of the event within the framework of fulfilling their role and tasks.

The legal basis for the data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 b) GDPR and Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) GDPR.

#### **2. Transmission to external recipients**

If we need to make a hotel reservation for you, we will share your personal information with transfer companies or hotels.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 b) GDPR.

In addition, we only pass on your personal data to service providers that we use to provide services or that are entrusted with the provision of our IT systems (e.g., service providers of the idloom platform).

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) GDPR.

Insofar as necessary for the fulfilment of our legal obligations, personal data will be passed on to the competent authorities. This applies, for example, to the forwarding of data to tax authorities and auditors.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 c) GDPR in conjunction with the relevant regulations.

### **VII. Erasure of data**

We only store your data for as long as it is required to fulfil the purpose for which it was collected or for as long as you have given your consent and there is no other legal basis for continued processing, in particular legal or contractual retention periods.

## VIII. Rights of the data subject

To exercise your rights and to lodge a complaint related to the processing of your personal data, please contact our data protection officers and/or data protection coordinators ([data-protection-group@strabag.com](mailto:data-protection-group@strabag.com)). Every natural person (data subject) has the following rights:

- Right of access (Art. 15 GDPR)
- Right to rectification of inaccurate data (Art. 16 GDPR)
- Right to erasure (Art. 17 GDPR)
- Right to restrict the processing of personal data (Art. 18 GDPR)
- Right to data portability (Art. 20 GDPR)
- Right to lodge a complaint to a data protection supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR)

**You may object to the processing of your personal data for direct marketing purposes at any time without stating reasons; this also applies to profiling insofar as it is associated with such direct marketing.**

**+You also have the right to object at any time on grounds relating to your particular situation to the processing of your personal data collected on the basis of Article 6 para. 1 sentence 1 f) GDPR. In this case, the objection must be substantiated and we will no longer process your data unless our interests in the processing prevail.**

If the data processing is based on consent, your consent can be revoked by you at any time with effect for the future. The revocation of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent until the revocation.

## IX. Status / Update

We adapt the information on data protection to changed functionalities or changed legal situations. We therefore recommend that you take note of the data protection notice at regular intervals. If consent is required, the changes will only be made with your consent.
